1 Current events of International , National and State Importance : It will cover events of national importance like coalition government system, economic liberalization, economic recession, regional extremism and separatist movements- Naxalism and Maoism; national security, internal security, communal harmony and international perspectives like nuclear policy issues and conflicts; impact of globalization on the socio-economic conditions of developing countries and global food crisis.	20 Marks
2 Sports and games: Questions based on important sports, games and tournaments, awards and personalities of the world, india and uttarakhand will be asked.	10 Marks
3 History of India: History of India will cover a broad understanding of ancient, medieval and modern India's political socio-economic and cultural aspects, Indian freedom movement, growth of nationalism and attainment of Independence.	15 Marks
4 General knowledge of Indian Constitution: Questions will be set on Indian Constitution as may be expected from an educated person who has not made a special study of the Constitution. Right to information, Right to Service, Right to education, Intellectual property rights and Consumer protection rights. Questions will also be asked on different Acts and Welfare programmes passed for the weaker and minority sections of society and different National and State Commissions for their upliftment.	15 Marks
5 Indian polity and Economy: The question will cover Indian polity, Panchayati raj and Community development, broad features of Indian economy and planning. Agriculture, Industry, trade and Service sector in Indian economy.	10 Marks
6 Geography of India and Demography: It will include questions on broad understanding of geographical, ecological, socio- economic and demographic aspects of India.	15 Marks
7 General Science, Technology and Environment: Questions on General science and environment will cover general understanding and application of science and environment including matters of day to day observation and experience, as may be expected from an educated person who has not made a special study of any particular scientific discipline such as global environmental problems and solutions, nutritional requirements for human growth, application of genetic engineering in human welfare; diseases of cattle, birds, plants and their prevention, Renewable and non-Renewable sources of energy.	20 Marks
8 Indian agriculture: Questions will cover the general awareness of candidates in respect of crops, white, yellow, and green revolutions, agricultural production and its contribution to rural economy, use of Nano and Bio-technologies in the field of agriculture, problems of Indian farmers and land reforms Classification of pesticides and their judicious uses. , Soil health and its improvement, Organic farming and its benefits.	10 Marks
9 Different Aspects of Urbanization: Concepts of urbanization, Challenges of urbanization, Aim of 74 th constitutional amendment, Urban planning, Solid waste management, Plastic waste management, financial management in Urban local bodies, Schemes for livelihood and poverty alleviation in urban areas, Inclusion of Information technology in providing citizen centric services in urban Areas, Concepts of environment protection in urban areas, Concepts of ease of living in Urban areas.	20 Marks

10 History of uttarakhand: Historical background of Uttarakhand: Ancient period (from earliest to 1200 AD); Mediaeval period (From 1200 to 1815 AD) Important dyansties and their achievements specially Katyuri, Parmar and Chand dynasties; Gorkha invasion and administration, British rule, Tehri State and Its administration, role of Uttarakhand in the Freedom Movement of India and related eminent personalities, major historical sites and monuments, movement for the formation of Uttarakhand, contribution of people of Uttarakhand in national and international fields, especially in Armed forces; different social reform movements and different welfare programmes of uttarakhand for SC, ST, children, minorities and women.	10 Marks
11 Culture of Uttarakhand: Castes and tribes, religious and folk beliefs, literature, folk literature, Jagar, traditions and customs, costumes and ornaments; Fairs and Festivals, Food habits, Art and Crafts, dances, songs, musical instruments, major tourist places, important sports, tournaments and awards, famous authors and poets of Uttarakhand and their contribution in the field of Hindi Literature and folk literature, steps taken by Uttarakhand Government for the development of culture.	10 Marks
12 Geogrphy and Demography of Uttarakhand: Geographical Setup. Salient features of Uttarakhand Himalaya, Rivers, mountains, climate, forest resources and horticulture of Uttarakhand. Major crops and crop rotation, Means of irrigation & Hydropower. Agricultural holdings. Natural and manmade calamities and disaster management. Water crises and watershed management. Problems of remote areas. Environment and environmental movements. Biodiversity and its preservation. Population of Uttarakhand: Classification, density, sex ratio, literacy and out migration.	10 Marks
13 Economic, political and Administrative Background of Uttarakhand: Political and Administrative Background in Uttarakhand- Elected governments in Uttarakhand and their policies, different services in the State, the political and administrative systems, Panchayti raj, Community development and Co-operatives. The historical background of the administrative system in Uttarakhand- Land management system under Gorkha and British rules district land management (Thokdari, van panchayat, civil and soyam forest, kesar-i-hind (Benap land), Nazul, Nayabad settlements). Modern period-Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand land reforms, change in land tenures and collection of land revenue after the enforcement of Zamindari Abolition Act, Revenue police system. Economic background in Uttarakhand - Indo Tibetan trade from border districts in ancient times, the present position, local agriculture, animal husbandry, the uneconomic condition of land holdings and need for consolidation of holding. Begar and Dadwar systems.	15 Marks
14 Economic and natural resources: of Uttarakhand - Human resources, Education system of the State and important educational Institutes; forest, water, herbs, agriculture, animals, hydroelectricity, minerals, tourism, industries the present position of utilization of resources. Various schemes being implemented in Uttarakhand for the eradication of poverty and unemployment and for economic development. Economic activities and their contribution in the state GDP. The priorities of development in Uttarakhand and new strategies of planning and problems. Marketing facilities in Uttarakhand and agriculture mandis. The salient features of the budget of Uttarakhand state.	10 Marks
15 Statistical analysis graphs and diagrams: Questions will be based on candidate's ability to draw conclusions from information presented in statistical, graphical and diagrammatical form and to interpret them.	10 Marks



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
